

2008 MS DG State Championship Rules

All PDGA rules apply unless otherwise stated herein or at the players meeting.

Out of Bounds

1. Road, parking lot and lake water are OB if your lie is surrounded by, totally in, on or across. Examples of OB road are holes 1, 10 & 12. Examples of OB lake are holes 11, 17 & 18.
2. Water not connected to the lake is not OB, example creek on hole 7 is not OB.
3. Concrete octagon and hexagon and adjacent or connected side walks near basket 16C are OB if your lie is surrounded by, totally in or on.
4. Fences are OB if there is no fencing between the tee and pin in play. Example that no part of the fence on holes 5, 7C or 8 is OB, but the fence is OB on holes 7A, 7B, 16 and 17.
5. The two (2) meter OB rule is IN effect - discs at rest completely above two meters from the playing surface are OB.
