Rule Reminders for 1st Timers

1. **Out of bounds** - 1 stroke added to score for the hole.
 - a. Throw from 1 meter straight in from last in bounds point.
 - b. Provisional throws can be used anytime the IB status of a lie is in question.
 - c. The OB line is OB. If you go over the fence early on 16 then it comes back and hits the outside of the fence and lands OB, your mark is not where it hit the fence because the fence is OB.

2. **Marking lie** - throw behind mark - your marker is your mini or your lie disc without moving it.

3. **Supporting points** at release - must have:
 - a. One (1) supporting point directly behind marker and within 30 cm (11"),
 - b. No supporting point closer to basket than back of marker,
 - c. No supporting point OB.

4. No **falling putt** within 10 meters - must demonstrate balance after release before advancing.

5. **One (1) meter from OB** relief
 - a. If your lie is in bounds but within 1 meter of an OB line you are allowed to mark your lie up to 1 meter straight in (90 degrees) from the OB line.
 - b. If your lie is out of bounds your mark is up to 1 meter straight in from the last point your disc was in bounds.

6. **Casual obstacles to stance** relief
 - a. Casual Obstacles include casual water, tree debris not connected to a tree, motor vehicles, harmful insects or animals, players equipment, spectators or any item or area specifically designated by the director before the round.
 - b. If no part of a casual obstacle is between lie and basket you can move it as needed to get a clear stance.
 - c. If any part is between the lie and basket you cannot move obstacle but can move your marker and throw from up to five meters back from the lie on the line of play as needed to achieve a stance without penalty.

7. **Permanent obstacle** relief - one (1) stroke penalty to relocate, 5 meters and no closer or previous lie.
